Learning Hub

The Compass 'Learning Hub' features a makers space, music/recording studio and a tinkering space where you can explore projects and workshops designed by you.



Kitchen Hub

At Compass, you can access a wide range of VET courses, some of which we deliver on site in our industry standard 'Kitchen Hub', featuring a full commercial kitchen, dining space and coffee pod!



Early Years Hub

We provide free access to on site childminding in our purpose-built 'Early Years Hub', for students who are responsible for the care of pre-school aged children.

FREQUENTLY ASKED :::::: QUESTIONS



Can I get my SACE here?

Definitely! Your Learning Facilitator (teacher) will work with you to ensure that your journey with Compass includes achieving your SACE. This can be done in stacks of different ways, all based around what you are interested in.



When can I start?

One of the great things about Compass is that we have rolling enrolments. So no need to wait until the next year, or the next semester... Ask about the next available starting date when you attend an information session.



What does a day look like?

The actual focus on each day will depend on what you are working on. But each day will start with a shared, free breakfast before you move into projects, workshops and individual time, always supported by your Learning Facilitator or a Learning Supporter.



How long does the program go for?

It goes for as long as you need it to – as long as you are still in the age range of 17 to 24. You will need to be participating and attending, but there is no fixed amount of time that you have to complete in.



What if I want to go to University?

Doing school at Compass won't earn you an ATAR directly, but if Uni is what you are aiming for, there are lots of pathways available that we can help you explore.



So, it's a Catholic school?

Yep, that's right. However we are here for people from all backgrounds, of all faiths or even no faith. Our Catholic values lead us to express ourselves in service – and Compass is all about that. We are a place that values individuals, and their journey – you won't get any judgement here.



FREE ON SITE CHILDMINDING



Compass Early Years Hub

The Compass Catholic Community Early Years Hub provides education and care for the children of parents attending our learning community.

We provide a safe and inclusive environment for pre-school aged children in our purposebuilt childminding space, so parents can focus on their learning.



How does it work?

- The Early Years Hub is open from 10am 3pm, Monday to Friday, during the school term only.
- Parents must be on site while their child/children are in the Early Years Hub.
- Food and nappies are supplied for children at no cost to you.
