If your child is unwell, please do not attend Compass and keep them home allowing time for recovery.

We follow the national guidelines of '**Staying Healthy (5th Edition)**' and use their rules and recommendations on how long the exclusion period will be in a case of infectious diseases.

If you're unsure, feel free to call or text the staff in the morning and we can talk you through it.

If your child becomes unwell throughout the day, the educators will contact you for early collection.



CLOTHING

Please pack a change of clothes and a jacket if needed. We often explore messy play and would love to be able to change them when necessary.

We follow the **Cancer Council Policy** and require children to wear hats and sunscreen when outdoors and the UV index is above 3.

Please supply a bucket hat for your child to wear while at school.
